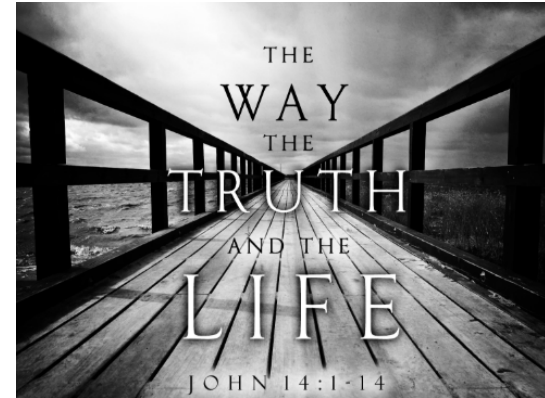
### **Community Announcements:**
