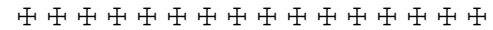

Church & Parish Announcements:

Today we celebrate Pentecost. While originally a Jewish festival (translated to Feast of Weeks) that celebrated the gathering of the wheat harvest, it later became a celebration of God’s giving of the Law to Moses on Mt. Sinai. In the Christian church year, Pentecost celebrates the day the Holy Spirit was given to the followers of Jesus so that they had the power and courage to preach the good news. This is why Pentecost is sometimes called the birthday of the Christian church. Pentecost is celebrated exactly 50 days after Passover, or seven weeks after Easter. The color of Pentecost Day is red for the fire of the Holy Spirit and for the blood of brave Christians who gave their lives because of their faith. The color for the season of Pentecost, however, is green for the long season of growth, except for Trinity Sunday and the Festival of Christ the King, when the color is white. Take notes, jot ideas and thoughts. Then, in the Bible study, we will discuss what was read and how it worked on you throughout the week. The first text we will review is **Matthew 9:9–13**.
