**Reminder** - our annual worship time starts on (8:30 Immanuel and 10 for SP) June 7 and will continue for the next year.

Starting on June 3, Immanuel will start up their **summer Wednesday Worship**, starting at 7 pm. This summer we will be exploring (and singing) our Lutheran hymn heritage, along with celebrating the Lord's Supper each service.

Our first **Wednesday Bible study** on the upcoming Gospel reading will be on June 3, at 6 pm. The practice is to read this throughout the week-read it multiple times a day (a good way to introduce the practice of daily prayer). Read it slowly, line by line. Then, in the Bible study, we will discuss what was read and how it worked on you throughout the week. The first text we will review is **Matthew 9:9–13**.

In the early church, Sunday worship would often lead to eating together (called, "Love Feasts"). Let's rediscover this practice and enjoy being in this salvation together! 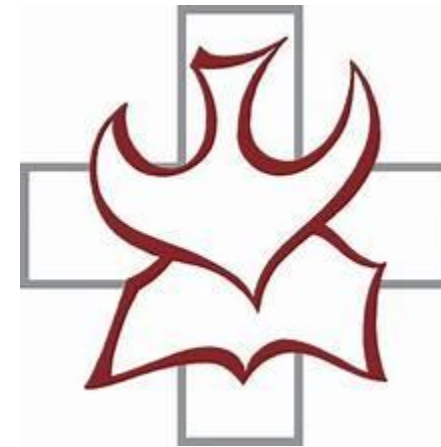
