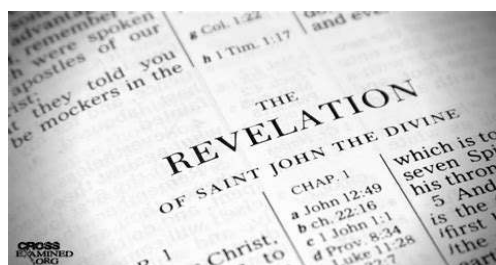

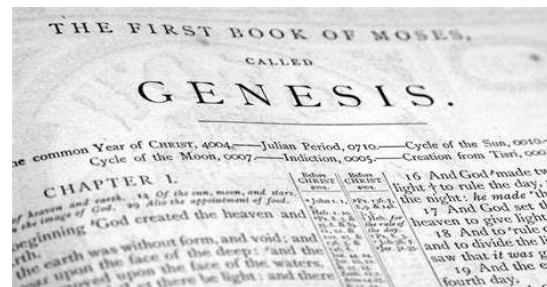
Pastor will be attending the NWD Fall Theological Conference in Appleton, Sept 28-30. He will be home each night if you need to reach him.

We are gearing up for another season of diving into our faith and what being a Baptized redeemed child of the Father has done for us.

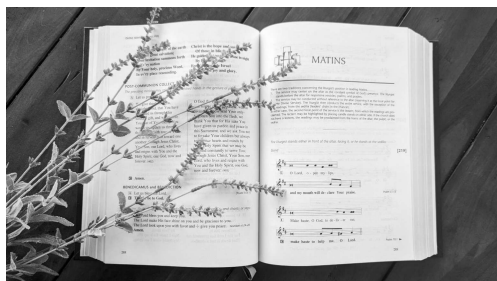
We are starting a new, in-depth Bible study after the last 3 years in the book of Romans. After feedback, we will begin digging into the oft-confused, but quite important **Book of Revelation**. We will again have 2 sessions, Tuesday nights at St Paul from 6-7 pm & Wednesday mornings at Immanuel from 9:30-10:30 am.



We will begin again another Bible study, this one meant to be quicker and more of an overview. This fall we will start at the other end of the Bible, at the beginning, the **Book of Genesis**. Unless requested different (or for more times), we will run this on Sunday evenings from 5-6 pm.



Our adult education offering will continue our look at our hymnal. As we finished the Divine Service, we will look at some of the other services we sing, Matins, Vespers, Compline and likely some of the other auxiliary services we have. After we finish with this, we will likely use some videos to explore a theme in apologetics (that is, the defense of the faith), speaking



to how we can assert the historicity and theological confession of the creation. We will run this on Sunday's from 6-7 pm.

These classes are meant for **ALL PEOPLE OF THE PARISH**. You don't even need to be confirmed-if our young people would like to attend, they are more than welcome. This is also a call for those who haven't attended studies before-make a commitment to increase your understanding and comprehension of our faith. Remember-Sunday School and Confirmation aren't to be seen as the end of our learning, just the beginning.
