This can be a picture of anything significant to your child!</i></p>	<p>Support children as they settle back into preschool routine or are introduced to preschool routine for the first time. (PSE)</p> <p>Encourage children to explore resources with their key worker to build positive relationships. (PSE)</p> <p>Support independence with encouraging children to find their name card, choose a peg, wash their hands and make independent choices at snack time. (PD)</p> <p>Provide a wide range of media to explore and be creative with so all preferences can be explored. (EAD)</p> <p>Focus on childrens home lives and families noticing differences and similarities. (UTW)</p> <p>Use the photographs provided from home as talking points in group scenarios. (UTW)</p> <p>Practice listening skills at story and circle times, encourage talking points when sat for meals. (CLL)</p> <p>Embed the concept of number into all aspects of play. Focus on numbers 1&2 when talking about their family, e.g. 1 bother, 2 Daddies. (MATHS)</p> <p>Story times before lunch to encourage concepts of rhyme and the value of the written word. (LITERACY).</p>	<p>Children will feel happy and secure coming to preschool. They will be comfortable in asking adults for help and know some names of their peers and adults forming positive relationships.</p> <p>Children will develop a sense of self whilst freely exploring their families, interests and preferences. This will provide the base for confident learning and exploring throughout preschool and into later life.</p> <p>By providing children with a wide range of media to explore with, children will be able to explore creative preferences. Do I enjoy getting messy? Am i comfortable holding a pencil? What patterns can I make with these colours?</p> <p>By creating a language rich environment with opportunities for sharing a listening within the routine, children will be able to effectively interact and communicate with those around them whilst developing speech clarity and vocabulary.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">- Parent consultations: W/c 14th Oct & 21st Oct.
