Learning about ourselves! What makes us unique? How do we prefer to play? What skills do I have? Can I use the right tools for the right purpose? Who is in my family? Who do I know in Preschool? What are my boundaries in Preschool?	Collect photos to create our own Preschool Family Scrapbook. Share these during circle times with the group to create a sense of community within preschool. (Those who were here last year may have already done this but feel free to update and/or add!) <i>Please can all parents send at least 1 photo to add to our scrapbook. If you do not have access to a printer, please email or whatsapp and we will print for you. This can be a picture of anything significant to your child!</i>	Support children as they settle back into preschool routine or are introduced to preschool routine for the first time. (PSE) Encourage children to explore resources with their key worker to build positive relationships. (PSE) Support independence with encouraging children to find their name card, choose a peg, wash their hands and make independent choices at snack time. (PD) Provide a wide range of media to explore and be creative with so all preferences can be explored. (EAD) Focus on children's home lives and families noticing differences and similarities. (UTW) Use the photographs provided from home as talking points in group scenarios. (UTW) Practice listening skills at story and circle times, introducing the 5 golden rules and encourage talking points when sat for meals. (CLL) Embed the concept of number into all aspects of play. Focus on numbers 1&2 when talking about their family, e.g. 1 brother, 2 Daddies. (MATHS) Story times before lunch to encourage concepts of rhyme and the value of the written word. (LITERACY).	Children will feel happy and secure coming to preschool. They will be comfortable in asking adults for help and know some names of their peers and adults forming positive relationships. Children will develop a sense of self whilst freely exploring their families, interests and preferences. This will provide the base for confident learning and exploring throughout preschool and into later life. By providing children with a wide range of media to explore with, children will be able to explore creative preferences. Do I enjoy getting messy? Am I comfortable holding a pencil? What patterns can I make with these colours? By creating a language rich environment with opportunities for sharing a listening within the routine, children will be able to effectively interact and communicate with those around them whilst developing speech clarity and vocabulary.	- Parent consultations: W/c 13th & 20th October.
