- Archives are an accumulation of historical records and materials that are being preserved because of their cultural, historical, or evidentiary value.
- Non profit archives include those in historical societies, not for profit businesses, set up with private funds from donors to preserve the papers and history of specific persons or places.

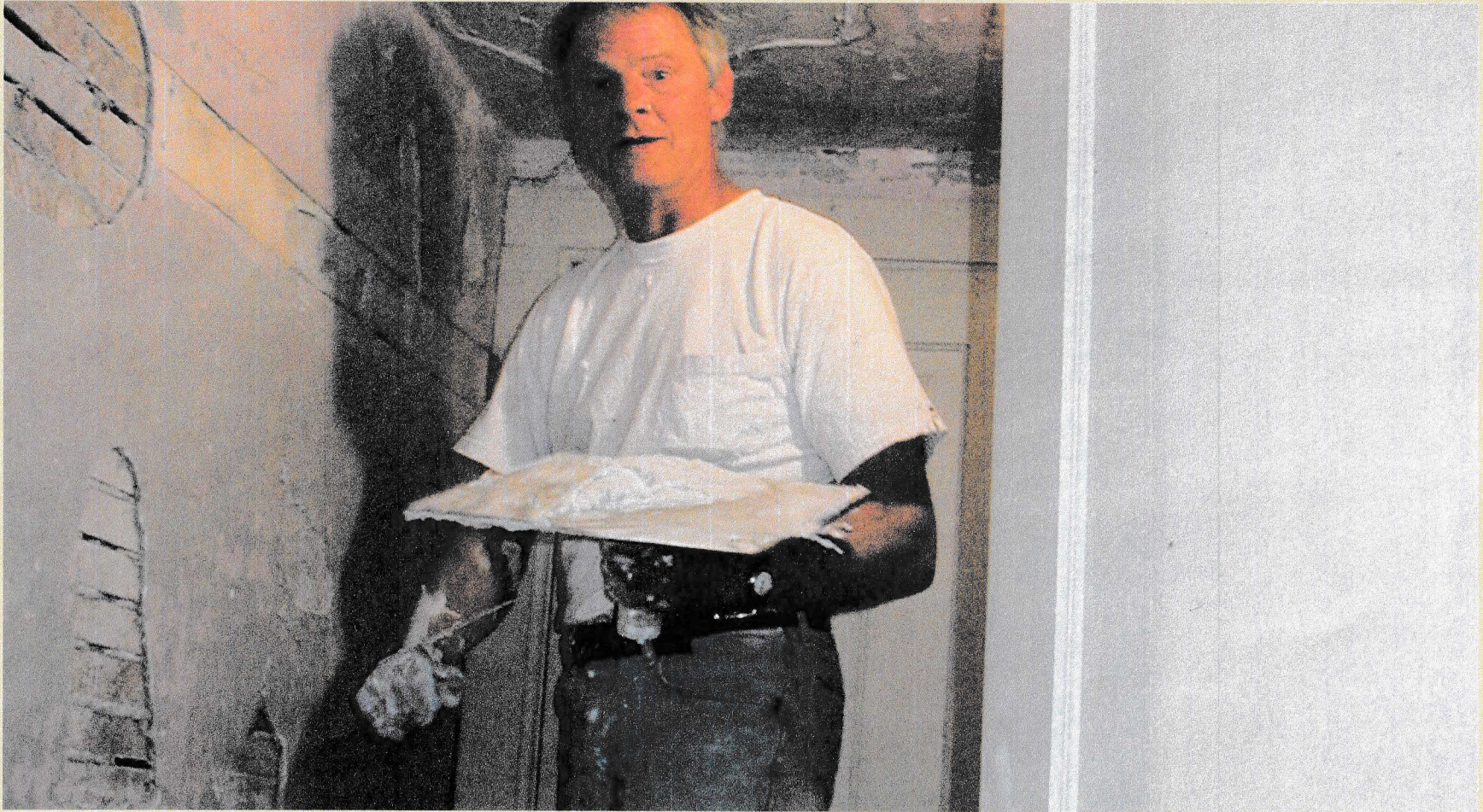
