Summary:

A trench was being dug at the rear of the property in the beer garden to install a badger fence. The top soil has been removed prior to the trench being dug.

The trench is being dug by machine to an average depth of 1800mm. At approximately 1000mm the disturbed ground gave way to the natural clay. Above the natural there are signs of cuts, most likely badger runs.

There are also dark layers which could be buried burnt material or rotting vegetation deposited by the badgers.

Finds:

Finds consisted of modern and 19th century ceramics and glass.

No archaeological features or deposits were observed.

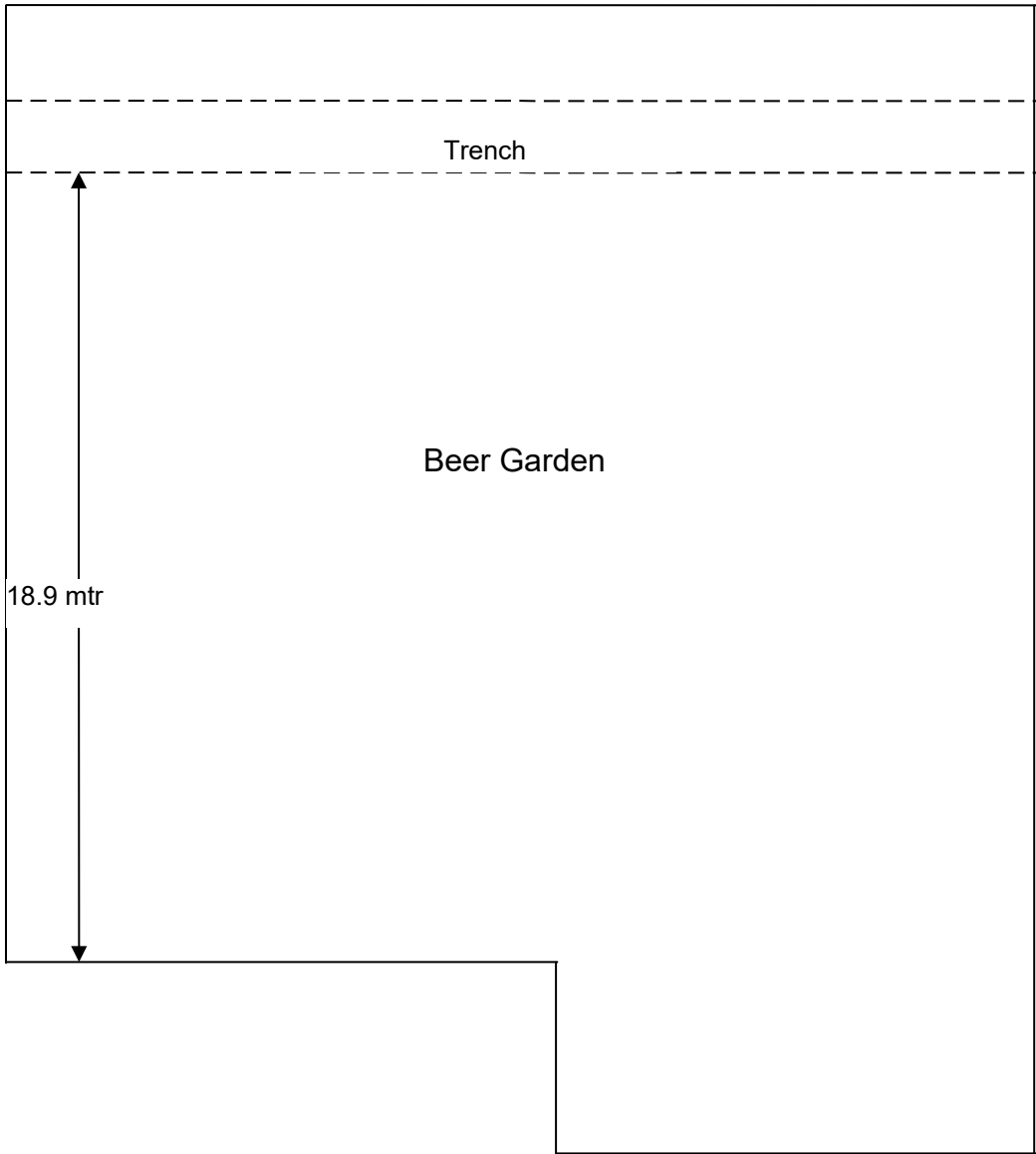

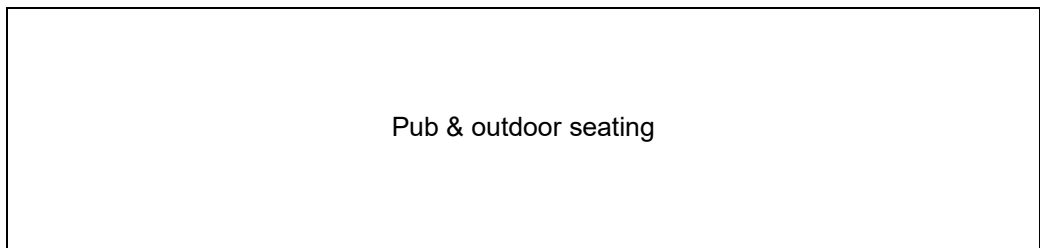
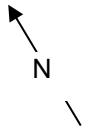
