

Winter League Rules



- 01 The Winter League will run from 1st January to the 31st March and then from the following 1st October to 31st December of a calendar year.
- 02 Guernsey Bailiwick shore caught fish are solely permitted for entry.
- 03 A maximum of three rods and four hooks are allowed per angler at any one time.
- 04 The League will be fished on a percentage basis; all fish to weigh a minimum of 1lb and be at least 25% of the Bailiwick record.
- 05 Members are encouraged to enter as many different species as possible.
- 06 Only one entry per species is allowed, however, any entry can be improved upon.
- 07 All fish must be weighed on club or electronic scales. The Fish Recorder must be notified of the fish within two days of capture and a weight certificate presented to him within a period of seven days from the date of capture.
- 08 The winner of the League shall be the angler with the highest overall percentage. The winners of the Pairs League shall be the team of two anglers with the highest aggregate percentage.
- 09 When fishing in the pair's competition, the fish recorder must be notified of the pair's team before the start of the Winter League.
- 10 All fish weighed in the winter league will be judged against the bailiwick record list as it stands on the 1st of January of each year for the entire competition, regardless of any amendments to the records list during the calendar year.
- 11 At the start of a calendar year, prior to the clubs AGM, subscriptions must be fully paid and a membership form completed prior to submitting fish. This only applies to individuals who were not a club member from the previous year.

Summer League Rules

- 01 The Boat Summer League will run from 1st April to the 31st September of a calendar year.
- 02 Guernsey Bailiwick boat caught fish are solely permitted for entry.
- 03 A maximum of three rods, with no min amount of hooks are allowed per angler, except when fishing on a charter boat, when Anglers will need to abide by the skippers instructions.
- 04 The League will be fished on a percentage basis; all fish to weigh a minimum of 1lb and be at least 25% of the Bailiwick record.
- 05 Members are encouraged to enter as many different species as possible.
- 06 Only one entry per species is allowed, however, any entry can be improved upon.
- 07 All fish must be weighed on club or electronic scales. The Fish Recorder must be notified of the fish within two days of capture and a weight certificate presented to him within a period of seven days from the date of capture.
- 08 The winner of the League will be the angler with highest overall percentage. The winners of the pairs shall be the team of two anglers with the highest aggregate percentage.
- 09 When fishing in the pair's competition, the fish recorder must be notified of the pair's team before the start of the Summer League.
- 10 All fish weighed in the Summer League will be judged against the Bailiwick record list as it stands on the 1st April of each year for the entire competition, regardless of any amendments to the records list during April to September.
- 11 When fishing in the Summer League boats must not be, attached or touching a pontoon or any other object that is fixed to the land.
