## EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM DESIGN

- **Piedmont Symphony Orchestra** - Program/Curriculum design for **PSO Music Mentors Program** - A visiting Residency program for Fauquier County VA music students. Curriculum and program goals designed around the VA Standards of Learning tests (SOL) and to follow the State Music Program of Studies. Residency program with extensive sectional and full ensemble work across two visits to the host school. Strings Residencies were offered at the launch of the program. Now in its fifth year the program has expanded into the Band programs in Fauquier County VA. Solely funded by grants and education donations. 2015-Present.
- **Piedmont Symphony Orchestra** - Program Design for annual **Student Visual Art Contest** Open to all art students in the Commonwealth of VA. All artwork is professionally adjudicated with winners receiving a cash award. Part of the PSO's annual Young People's Concert in which student artwork is based on the theme of the concert and projected above the orchestra in real time. 2005-Present.
- **Fairfax Symphony Orchestra** - Program/Curriculum design for **FSO Classical Kids Club Program** - A visiting musical/historical/multimedia presentation program for Fairfax County VA elementary students—particularly in Title 1 school demographics. Curriculum and program goals designed around the VA Standards of Learning tests (SOL) and to follow the State Music Program of Studies. Solely funded by grants and education donations. Presented at nearly 100 FCPS elementary schools. 2006-2010.
- **Florida Youth Conservatory** - Program design for K -12 Music curriculum ranging from General Music through high school and adult Instrumental, Choral and Community ensembles. Oversight of artistic/operations of academic based music program on two campuses totaling roughly 500 school and community students. Introduced extensive Guest Artist/Master Class and Side by Side series of renowned talent within and visiting South Florida. Educational partnership with local professional orchestra. At the close of operations the program supported a Full/Part time degreed music and administrative staff of 25 people. Lighthouse Point and Coconut Creek FL, 1998-2001.
