



RANK & REWARD SYSTEM

Umpire Rankings:

- **Senior Umpire Rank (SUR)**
 - **900** 85% on Evaluation, 5 years of service, & 125+ points on PRS
 - **800** 80% on Evaluation, 5 years of service, & 115+ points on PRS
 - **700** 75% on Evaluation, 5 years of service, & 105+ points on PRS
- **Certified Umpire Rank (CUR)**
 - 600 70% on Evaluation, 4+ years of service, & 85 points on PRS
 - 500 70% on Evaluation, 3+ years of service, & 85 points on PRS
 - 400 70% on Evaluation, 2+ years of service, & 85 points on PRS
- **Associate Umpire Rank (AUR)**
 - 300 70% on Evaluation, 0-2 years of service, & 70 points on PRS
 - 200 60% on Evaluation, 0 years of service, & 60 points on PRS Over 16 Y.O.
 - 100 60% on Evaluation, 0 years of service, & 60 points on PRS Under 16 Y.O.
 - 000 New Umpire – Rookie – Starting Out

You will be scheduled every 3 years for an evaluation. An evaluation score is good for 3 years. You can request 2 additional evaluations each year. You keep the highest evaluation score received with the corresponding date the evaluation was given.

Additional evaluations will be done after base evaluations are completed for the year. No one is notified when an evaluation is scheduled. You should be at your best every time you are on the field.

A newer umpire ***with good experience*** may request a board approved early rank without meeting all the criteria immediately. To maintain the board ranking all criteria MUST be met within the time frame given by the board at the time of the approved early ranking.

You can advance within a rank by improving your scores on evaluations and the PRS. To advance from rank to rank requires board approval. I.E. if you are a new umpire ranked at AUR 000 you can move up to AUR 300 by meeting the needed requirements of 70 points eval and 60% PRS. To move to a CUR 400 from AUR 300 you must meet the criteria of the CUR 400 and receive board approval.
