A brief history of Broken Hill and the Far West NSW region



The history of Broken Hill is a story of trials and triumphs. There are many opportunities to delve deeper into the history of the region once you have settled in. The account below provides a brief outline of some of the events that have contributed to the rich history of the region.

Broken Hill was founded by a young German boundary rider who discovered the rich orebody that became known as the Line of Lode, in 1883. The discovery of the rich line of lode in Outback New South Wales was an important event in the young history of Australia.

Surveyor and explorer Major Thomas Mitchell was the first reported European in the area in 1835.

In 1844, **Charles Sturt** named the Barrier Ranges and mentioned a "broken hill". Although Sturt's expedition failed to find the Australian inland sea, their mapping and descriptions of the far northwest helped to open up this unknown region.

Pastoralists followed the early explorers in the 1850's.

In 1860, Burke and Wills established a base in Menindee during their ill-fated expedition to the Gulf of Carpentaria.

Silverton was established after the discovery of silver and lead deposits in 1883 and reaches its peak population of approximately 3000 by the end of 1885.

Charles Rasp, a German boundary rider who worked at Mount Gipps station pegged the first claim on top of the "broken hill". Rasp thought the hill would contain deposits of tin, but first samples examined in Adelaide showed quantities of lead and zinc with traces of silver.

On September 5, 1883, Rasp registered his mining lease. Mount Gipps station manager George McCulloch, James Poole, David James, George Lind and George Urquhart joined, and together they formed the "**Syndicate of Seven**".



At the turn of the century, **27,000 people lived and worked in Broken Hill**, the town had 60 licenced hotels and in 1905 Broken Hill's population reached more than 30,000.

The Battle of Broken Hill took place on New Year's Day 1915 when two Afghan men, pushing an ice-cream cart, hoisted a Turkish Flag and fired upon a trainload of people who were headed to a New Year's Day picnic. Since Australia was at war at the time with the Ottoman Empire, the men were first thought to be Turkish, but were later identified as being from the British colony of India (modern day Pakistan). They killed four people and wounded six others, before they were killed by a group of policemen and soldiers.

In 1915, the population of Broken Hill peaked at 35,000.

In 1919/20, the great strike rages, the strike lasted 18 months and began the recognition of rights and conditions for the mining industry.

Following bitter industrial disputes in the early 20th century, the Broken Hill **Barrier Industrial Council** was formed in 1923. It was an affiliation of 18 unions. As a result, working conditions in the mines finally began to improve.

The first train from Sydney arrived in Broken Hill in 1927. It had taken 40 years of campaigning.

One of the earliest known and documented ecological regeneration projects to occur in Australia and the world took place in Broken Hill over the period 1936-1958. A collaborative effort led by amateur botanist Albert Morris, a mining company senior assayer, ecologist, conservationist, and regenerator. The resulting regeneration reserve was classified by the National Trust as a landscape Conservation Area in 1991.

In August 1936, Albert initiated the construction of the first set of **Broken Hill Regeneration Reserves**.

After the Second World War (1939-1945), new reserves were constructed and by 1958 Broken Hill was fully encircled by a completed regeneration area.

In 1839, BHP leaves Broken Hill.



1942 saw the construction of the munition's annexe, employing 300 women and 84 men, producing 637,606 nose cones for shells until the end of WWII.

From 1942 – 1945, the Broken Hill Gaol houses the nation's gold reserves in a special steel lined vault.

In 1954, **Queen Elizabeth visits Broken Hill** and broadcasts a message to outback listeners linked with the Flying Doctor base.

The **Broken Hill School of the Air** opened in 1956 to combat the lack of educational facilities in remote areas.

In 1960, the **Menindee Lakes Storage Scheme** opens, guaranteeing a continuous water supply to Broken Hill and offering recreational water sports to the community.

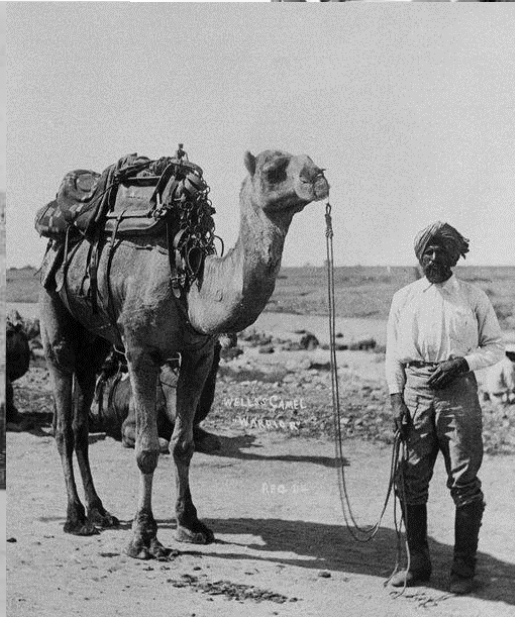
1984 saw the end of the long-established but illegal Crystal Lane **Two-up School**.

In 2015, Broken Hill became the first city in Australia to be included on the **National Heritage list**.

Today, Broken Hill continues to thrive, more than 130 years of mining, a 300 million tonne mineral system makes Broken Hill one of the longest continual mining towns in the world.

Our history and heritage are important to us and the history of Australia but we continue to grow our region, create opportunities to ensure our next generations have the chance to enjoy the lifestyle and opportunities that have made Broken Hill and the Far West the greatest place in Australia to live, work, invest and raise your family.

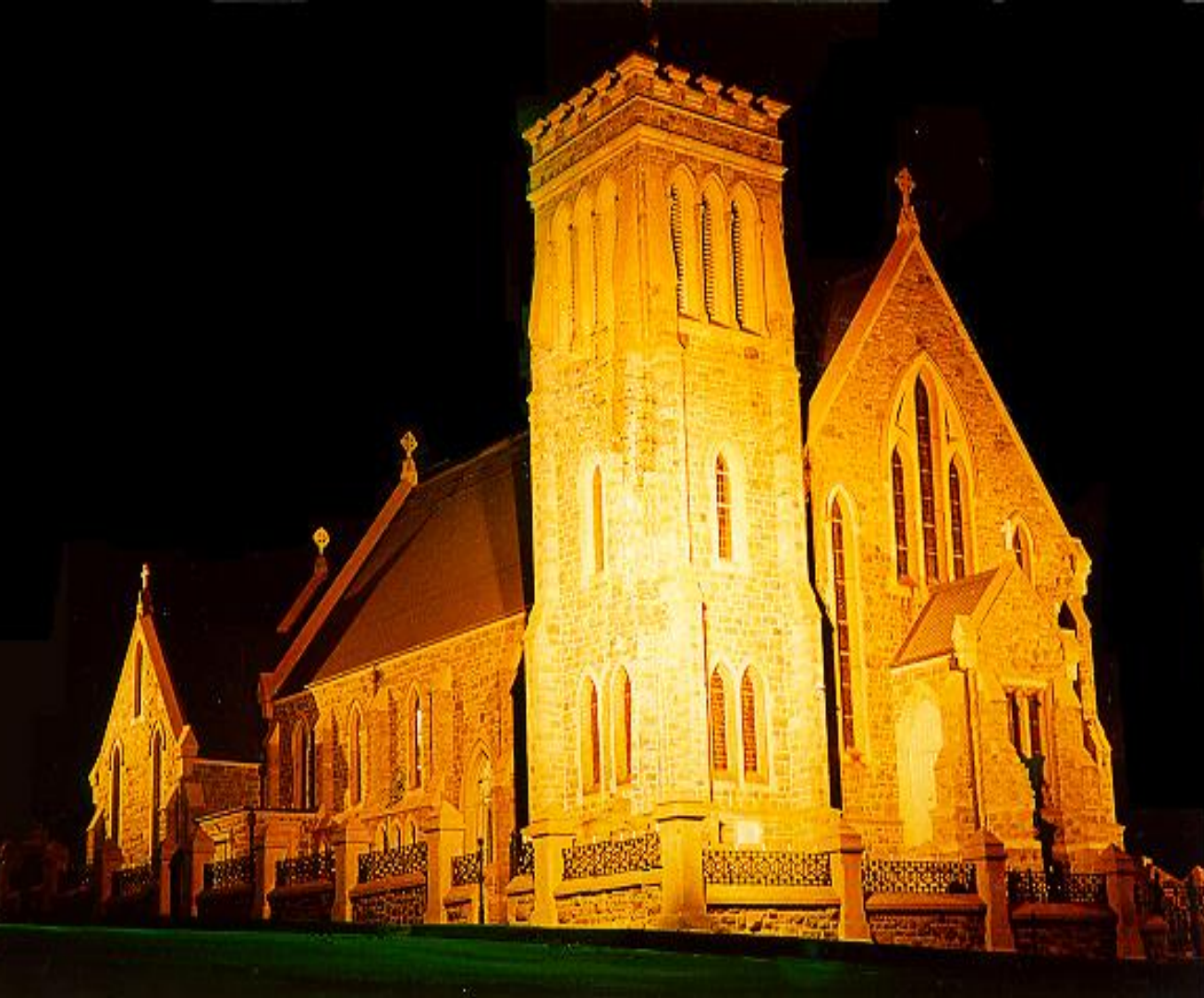

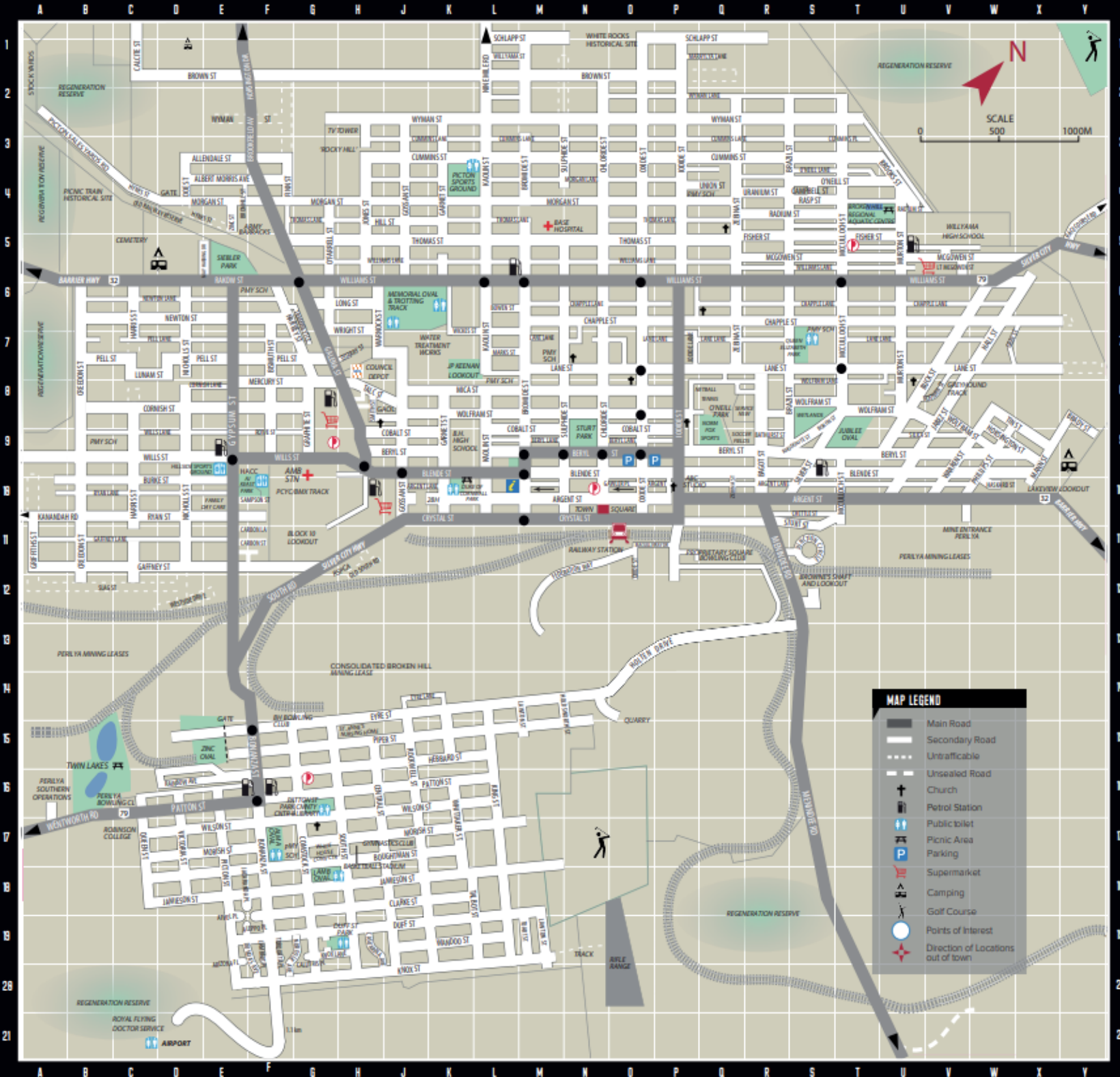
