

Workshop Description

As part of the final stage of project implementation, each partner school organized the workshop entitled “**Our Project Meets VET Schools, the Electronics and ICT Industries, and the Labor Market**”, an event that represented the culmination of the activities carried out throughout the 18 months of collaboration.

The workshop lasted one day and was held in the partner schools’ home cities, bringing together participants from the local and regional communities. Among them were: teachers and trainers from VET schools, representatives of the electronics and ICT sectors, local education authorities, and institutional partners.

Workshop Objectives

- To present the objectives, results, and products achieved within the project;
- To promote the training guide and Arduino kits developed by the partners;
- To exchange experiences and best practices between educators and industry representatives;
- To evaluate the usefulness of the project’s products through feedback sessions and brainstorming;
- To strengthen collaboration between education, industry, and the labor market.

Activities Carried Out

The event began with a plenary opening session, during which the project coordinator presented the objectives achieved and the impact of the activities undertaken. Subsequently, the partners presented the Arduino training guide and educational kits, explaining how these can be used in schools and vocational training contexts.

Participants were engaged in an interactive brainstorming session, where they analyzed the strengths and areas for improvement of the materials produced. Concrete proposals were generated regarding the extension of Arduino applications to more advanced industrial fields and the more effective integration of resources into the school curriculum.

Results and Impact

The workshop succeeded in:

- Ensuring visibility and validation of the project results at local and regional levels;
- Creating a framework for collaboration between educational institutions, authorities, and representatives of the economic sector;
- Providing participants with a clear picture of how the project results can be transferred and applied in practice;
- Encouraging the continuation of international cooperation through new educational initiatives and Erasmus+ partnerships.
