

DIGITAL DUPR CLUB and NBPC

Feel free to ignore this information if you won't be playing in any NBPC DUPR sessions (although please note that the vast majority of our club's members do play in some NBPC DUPR sessions, so we encourage you to give it a try).

In order to play in an NBPC DUPR session, you must, BEFORE playing in the Session, join NBPC's Digital DUPR Club (which is in addition to joining DUPR, which is what you did when you registered with Pickleball Canada this season). Joining NBPC's Digital DUPR Club is necessary so that NBPC's DUPR Administrators are authorized to enter the results of all of your NBPC DUPR Games (without them first having to get the game results digitally verified by all of the players, which would be very time-consuming).

You can join NBPC's Digital DUPR Club, (which is free) by doing the following:

- Log-in to DUPR.com.
- Once you've logged in, click on "Clubs".
- Our Nanoose Bay Pickleball Club name should come up then (but if it doesn't, then enter "Nanoose Bay" in the Search field).
- Once the NBPC name comes up, click on our club's name and then our club's profile page should come up.
- Click on the "Join Club" button.

If you have difficulty doing any of this, please email us at nanoosebaypickleballclub@gmail.com, and then we'll try to get DUPR to send you an Invitation email with a link to accept the invitation to join NBPC's Digital DUPR Club.

One last thing: Once you've joined NBPC's Digital DUPR Club, you might not see your name listed under the "Rankings" heading (as that section only lists players with a DUPR Rating which has a high Reliability Score); however, if you click on the "Members" tab, then the names of all members of NBPC's Digital DUPR Club should be listed.
