

When our twinning friends visited Wlrksworth in June 2023, Aquabox gave a presentation and organised a visit to the depot located on Cromford Hill. The Twinning Association

presented a gift of a water filter to each of the towns, so they could spread the word about Aquabox.

Aquabox provides safe drinking water and humanitarian aid to people affected by natural disasters, extreme weather and conflicts. Clare Wesson in Die has since demonstrated the filter at their local market and had other fund raising events and, when she visited Wirksworth in December, she presented Aquabox with a cheque for £250 she had raised. Aquabox were delighted to receive this and will continue to support the twin towns in spreading the message about its life saving charity.
