*Die, pronounced 'dee' is in South East France in the valley of the river Drôme, close to the Regional Park of the Vercors Plateau. With a population of about 4,000, the town is an important local centre famous for its sparkling wine - Clairette de Die.*

## Frankenau



*Frankenau, and the villages of Allendorf, Altenlotheim, Dainrode, Ellershausen and Louisendorf (combined population around 3,000) is close to the River Eder in Hessen, central Germany. This is an area of rolling hills and forests. There is a historical link between these villages and the Huguenots, who fled there from the Diois in France in the late 17th century.*

## Varallo



*Varallo is on the Sesia river in the Piedmont region of north-west Italy,. We are developing ties with Varallo, which has been twinned with Die for many years. The town was a place of pilgrimage in medieval times. It has many artistic treasures, including the Sacro Monte. It is famous for its carnival celebrations.*
