

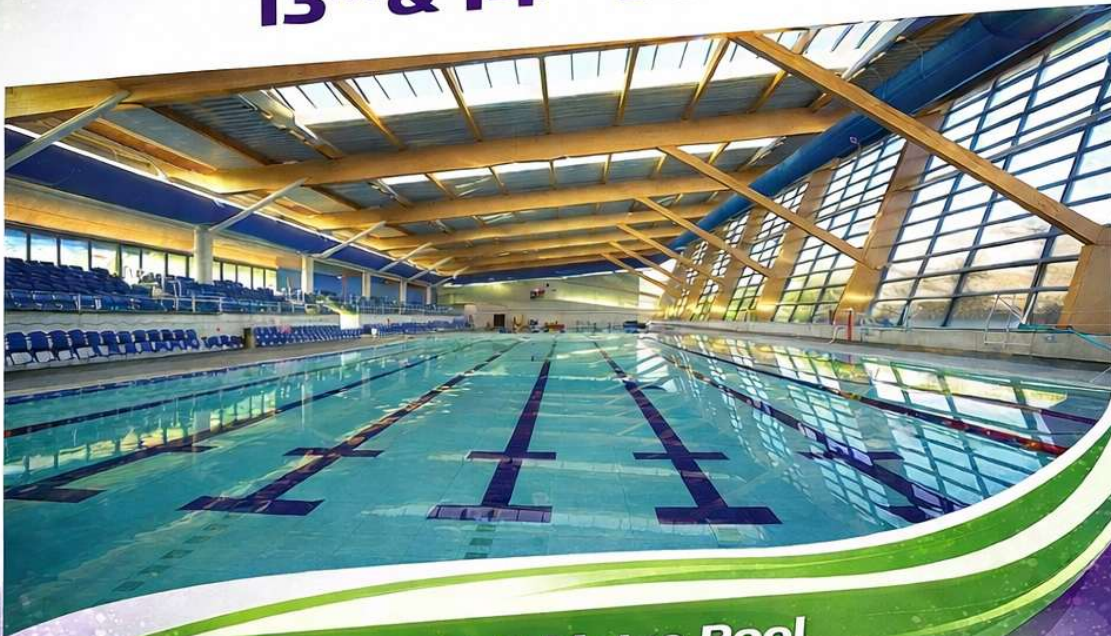

8 lane 50m pool; cooldown pool; electronic timing; anti-wave ropes.

Ages as at last day of event. (As of 14th June 2026)

'Hot Heats' will be run on both days. This is a specially designated, random heat, with music, and announcements-the winner of the heat will receive a prize.

Awards:

Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in each age group for each event. Trophy award for best team. Medals can be collected from the medal desk after the announcements of result have been made. Medals will be ready collection during the session. A swimmer unable to pick up their medal personally should send a deputy to pick up the medal on their behalf.



Entry Times:

There are no QT's or UCT's for this meeting.

In the event where entries exceed capacity, the meet organisers reserve the right to bring the closing date forward. Any swimmers not accepted will have their fees returned.

Entry Fee:

The **electronic** price of entry is £9.50 per event except for the 800m and 1500m which is £11.50.

The price of **individual** entry is £12 per event except for the 800m and 1500m which is £14. Payment is due with the entry and proof of payment is required before the entry will be processed.

Entries with Long Course times (Short Course conversions accepted) should be submitted using the HyTek entry file available.

Coaches/TM Passes:

Coaches and TM passes are £15 each, per day or £25 for the weekend to include start list, lunch and refreshments. Passes may be requested on the day but will only be issued with proof of a valid DBS, relevant Safeguarding Certificate and valid role specific qualification.

Entering clubs should ensure that the supervising TM's and Coaches attending, comply with the safeguarding requirements as stated above.



Please contact: treasurerswimconwy@gmail.com to apply for poolside passes. Passes must be always worn whilst on poolside and will be required to gain access.

Poolside passes/packs will be available from the admissions desk before the start of the meet and will include warm up information and break time information (this will also be emailed to clubs in advance)

A free poolside pass will be provided to any club providing licensed officials to all 4 sessions.

1. This competition will be held under Swim Wales Laws and Swim Wales Technical Rules.
2. This meet is open to all members of a club affiliated to Swim Wales/ Swim England/Scottish Swimming, or their own national association as appropriate. They must be eligible to compete and may enter in the name of one club only.
3. Entry times must be recorded in British Rankings (Levels 1-4) between 1st January 2025 and the closing date. Converted times will be accepted.
4. The submission of entries, either electronic or by email indicates an acceptance of the meet conditions. Entries will not be accepted until the appropriate payment is received.
5. The promoter reserves the right to limit entries to meet gala license timing restrictions. Where this rule is invoked, the swimmers with the slowest times submitted will take precedence. Events chosen for restrictions will be at the meet organisers discretion. In this case, within each event, entries will be restricted to the slowest times within each age group on a pro-rata basis.
6. Poolside entries will not be accepted. Once the entry file has been submitted, improved times will not be accepted. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the promoter.
7. There will be no reserve list run at this meet.
8. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given, as required by GDPR, to the holding of personal information on a computer. Personal data, including submitted and recorded times, will be available during the meet.
9. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim Wales's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
10. Swimmers with disabilities will be accepted and all classes of swimmers will swim together in inclusive events.



Officials:

To allow this Gala to take place, each club entering the Gala is asked to provide officials. Please provide as many officials as you have available, but, as a minimum clubs should provide 1 official for under 10 athletes competing, between 10 and 20 athletes competing 2 officials etc.

Officials will be provided with refreshments throughout the day and free lunch. Expenses will be paid.

In the event of over subscription those clubs who have not provided officials will be at risk of being scratched first.

Marshalls: Anyone who is available to help but not a qualified official – volunteers for marshalling etc will also be needed.

General:

1. A copy of the venue's competition safety briefing can be found at the venue reception.
2. Over the top starts will be used.
3. Warm Up/Swim Down pool will be available. Clubs through their team staff MUST supervise their swimmers in the swim down pool and be responsible for the behaviour/actions of their swimmers within the facility. Swimmers using these facilities must follow any instructions issued by the lifeguards. If the Swim Down Pool is not used in a sensible manner, it will be closed.
4. It is the responsibility of swimmers to report to the marshalling area in sufficient time for each event. The promoter of this event cannot be held responsible for any swimmer missing their heat by turning up late.
5. If cancellation of the event is necessary, then the only claim will be the entry fees paid.
6. Swim Conwy will not be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during this meet.
7. Any point not covered by these conditions will be at the discretion of the meet promoter. Depending upon the situation, the meet promoter or referee's decision respectively will be final.

Heats:

Competitors will be seeded according to submitted times, **slowest to fastest**. Coaches should ensure that swimmers make themselves available for marshalling at least 2 events prior to the event they are competing in.

Spectators:

Spectator tickets/wrist bands will be available on the door. An entry fee applies, Price tbc.

Under 16s are free and concessions will also be available.

Safeguarding:

Clubs are required to provide team managers at the ratio required by Swim Wales to always supervise their swimmers throughout the event. Please see the latest Swim Wales policy.

Media Policy:

Mobile phone use in line with Swim Wales guidance is strictly forbidden in the changing rooms and is not allowed on the pool deck. Video and Photography are allowed from the spectator's gallery. Anyone wishing to capture the swimming is requested to focus on their own swimmer and refrain from posting on social media/public forums if other swimmers are in the frame.

Data:

By submitting entries, consent is thereby given, as required by GDPR, to the holding of personal information on a computer. Personal data including submitted and recorded times will be available during the meet. When entering this event, you agree that we may collect and publish personal information as part of the entry to and results of the event. We may pass such information to the Governing Body or Affiliated organisations for the purpose of membership and qualification checking. Following that, your personal information will be used for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compared to other events (British Rankings). The published results may include (but not limited to) Name, Club Membership, Race Times, Age Category.

Administration: A meets results service will operate throughout the competition. A meet office will be in operation for the duration of the weekend located in the spectator area. Any conditions not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the promoter-Swim Conwy.
