# Best Practices in Bali's Tourism Development

## Cultural Preservation:

- Cultural heritage. Local communities preserving traditional art forms, dance, and rituals.
- Integrated cultural tourism

## Infrastructure Development:

- Investment in improving transportation (e.g., Ngurah Rai International Airport upgrades).
- Expansion of resorts and facilities in alignment with sustainable practices.





# Building a Supportive Tourism Environment in Bali

## Public-Private Partnerships:

- Collaboration
- Destination marketing campaigns such as “Visit Bali Year” and digital promotion.

## Government Support:

- Incentives for Investment
- Community-based tourism policy and investments in sustainable tourism infrastructure.

## Tourism Growth Requires Long-Term Planning:

- **Sustainable Infrastructure:**

- **Community-Based Tourism:**  
Involve local communities

over-tourism, including overcrowding and environmental degradation.

Plan for sustainable growth
- **Cultural and Social Tensions:**  
The commercialization of local culture.  
*Lesson for Timor-Leste:*  
Cultural preservation and community consultation
- **COVID-19 Impact:**  
Economic diversification and domestic tourism and digital innovations.  
*Lesson for Timor-Leste:*  
Diversify tourism offerings.

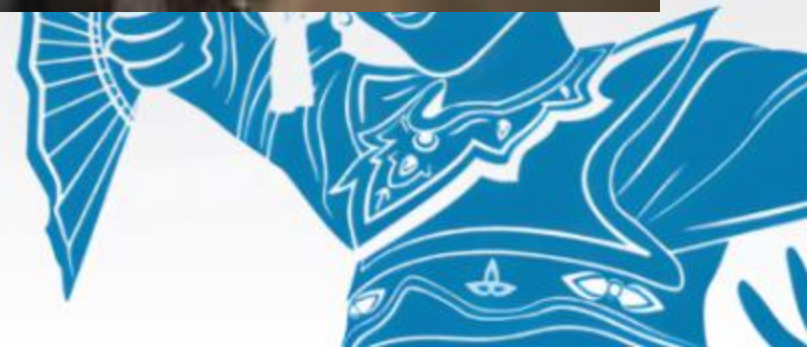




# Workforce Development, Community Engagement, and Technology

## Attracting Investors:

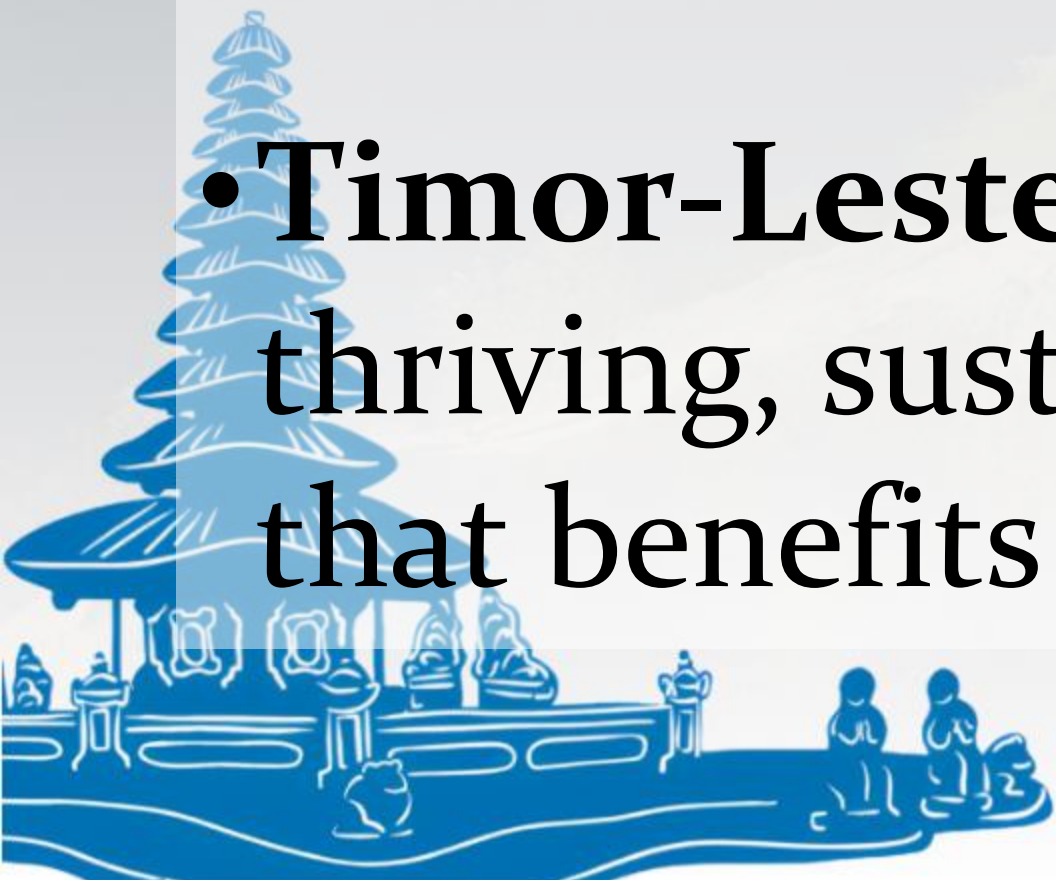
- **Government Support:** Policies and incentives to encourage tourism investment.
