### SING MODESTLY.

Do not bawl, so as to be heard above or distinct from the rest of the congregation, that you may not destroy the harmony...

#### SING IN TIME.

Whatever time is sung, be sure to keep with it. Do not run before nor stay behind it; but attend closely to the leading voices, and move therewith as exactly as you can...

#### ABOVE ALL SING SPIRITUALLY.

Have an eye to God in every word you sing.
