

<u>MINISTRY CHALLENGE</u> World Communion week: let's work with other believers in our united service within the community as we declare God's love in Jesus Christ.

LAST WEEK ... Prayer always "connects" us with God! That's why Paul urges his young protégé, Timothy, to pray fervently. He actually gives instructions on how to do it. He calls for "supplications": requests that we might lift up during worship time as "prayers of the people." Sometimes it's good for the whole faith community to hear prayer requests, so that people can get involved. He calls for "prayers": the kind of petitions that only God can answer. We can't answer all this worlds' needs; some things only God can fix! Paul also tells young Timothy to pray "intercessions": prayers in which we "go to God" on behalf of another person. Moses did this well. So did Jesus. It is "getting involved" as an advocate for a friend. We must even pray for ungodly or lazy leaders who "aren't so great". Paul called his trainee to pray through 'thanksgivings': basking in God's glow. This is our way: praying with great commitment. Spend time in prayer. Don't let it be your LAST resort. Make it your FIRST resort! The New Testament mentions prayer nine time as often as music or singing. Yes, pray for your church! Let your fingers help you in your "prayer priorities": (thumb) those closest to you, (index finger) those who teach/instruct, (tallest, middle finger) our leaders/authorities, (ring finger) those who are weak and, finally, (pinky) ourselves (1 Timothy 2:1-8)
