

<u>MINISTRY CHALLENGE</u> ... Do something nice for someone. As you do, let them know that "Jesus loves you". Most folks will come to understand that there's a connection between our surprising good works and God's awesome love in Christ!

LAST WEEK ... A silly internet quiz suggested that Pastor Mike's "match state" would be Illinois. But that is NOT Mike's land! Christopher Columbus knew the

promise in a new land. Moses helped his people to prepare for their land ahead. Israel had to know the blessings and responsibilities in that new place. The good land ahead would be filled with springs; believers remember that Jesus is our Living Water! The good land offers resources reflecting our relationship with God. Even the minerals signify a future to "settled people" who are no longer scavenger nomads. God's people were warned of being prideful and complacent: they must never sit back: thinking that they have "made it". Same with us today: we must never forget the Lord, abandoning his ways. Worshipful living takes place "not between the prelude and the benediction (one hour), but between the benediction and prelude" (167 hours!). Believers embrace the fullness of such joy in Christ. The Lord is leading us into a good land...let's step into that place, rejoicing in His "Pomegranate Promise" (Deuteronomy 08:07-18)
