A parable of talents is a practical look at investing God's gifts. Long ago, rich guys delegated the control of their wealth to trustworthy employees, expecting a return on their money. Three servants were entrusted with great gifts (their master was going on a trip). One man received about 5 million dollars. One got 2 million. The third: a million. The first two put their 'trusts' to work and thus increased their holdings. They were praised by their master. The third guy dug a hole and buried his 'trust'. So he was roundly excoriated. Good stewards don't 'bury God's blessings'; they 'plant them in His field of service'. We have all been gifted; don't hide your unique gift in a hole. Use your given talents and opportunities to God's glory. And don't compare what you've
