LAST WEEK ... "Do not forsake me, O my darling": The Ballad of High Noon tells of a cry for support in tough times. Today, Christians are called to "stay the course". Long ago, Jesus had just fed thousands with a few morsels becoming a feast. Afterwards, He declared that it is ONLY by taking HIM into one's life that we might receive Eternal Life. In this "least successful sermon of all time", church membership seemed to go from thousands to about 12. Our loyalties are fickle. Church members often prove to be unfaithful when things aren't going "swimmingly" and when others fall away. As Jesus watched many of the so-called disciples turn away from Him, he asked the core group "will you leave me, too?" Peter ("being typically Peter") cried out: "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life". In a world with many diversions, distractions, callings, causes, philosophies and elections: to whom shall we go? Only Jesus, the One called "Bread Of Life" is the real deal. Is your faithfulness seen in your hanging in there when you feel wounded and weary? Jesus has promised to never leave or forsake us. Will you do the same for Him in seasons when you are spiritual stressed out and when your friends fall away? (John 6:60-66)
