<u>MINISTRY CHALLENGE</u>...Let joy be in you. As sinners forgiven by God's grace, let's always serve others in humility, remembering that we, too, were 'lost outsiders'!

<u>LAST WEEK</u> ... Every leader in history (except one) has been flawed. With that, most everyone is happy that election season is over! We were reminded that Old Testament high priests were also selected among the people. Back in the day, a high priest knew what it meant to both sin and to be sinned against. That's why he had to offer sacrifices for his own sins as well as his people. He was a descendant from the first high priest, Aaron. Melchizedek was a king and high priest with no such a lineage from Aaron. Genesis 14 describes him as seeming to "drop out of Heaven" to greet Abram with wine and bread after an important battle. Jesus was appointed by His heavenly father to be a different kind of high priest, in that mysterious order of Melchizedek. He was not elected from the people: God sent Him. He offered prayers and petitions, serving as our "forever high priest". His death at Calvary meant "no more goat blood" making paving the way. Messiah's obedient submission became the source of salvation for all who obey him. Yes, our leaders are all sinners...but we follow in the humble, eternal ways of our King who was priest 'and then some'!
