

LAST WEEK ... Jesus was in a crowd, but He still had time for synagogue ruler Jairus, who asked that the rabbi come to help his dying 12-year old daughter. Jesus still had time for the woman who was suffering with a 12-year bleeding that wouldn't stop. As she reached out to touch Him, power went from Him and healed that woman. It wasn't magic. It was faith. Jesus went along to the ruler's home, even though news had come of her death. Our Lord reached out and touched her, and she was revived! He prescribed a little food for her. For us, Jesus prescribes faith. The faith that these "outsiders" had when they approached Jesus (one from the back, the other from the front) is just the kind of faith that we need today. Jesus longs to make a change in us. We might think that it is our "pressing through the crowd" that makes all the healing difference. In reality, it is Jesus "pressing through the crowd" to us that restores us from all brokenness. Thank the Lord for always "Reaching Out To You". (Mark 5:21-34)
