

(2) Fling wide the portals of your heart; make it a temple, set apart From earthly use for heaven's employ, adorned with prayer and love and joy.


(3) Redeemer, come, with us abide; our hearts to thee we open wide; Let us thy inner presence feel; thy grace and love in us reveal.

**LAST WEEK**...Our offerings must reach 'beyond midnight' in a spirit of gratitude.

Preachers often apologize for talking about THANKFUL giving. Jesus wasn't shy about it! The New Testament talks "money" more than prayer! Paul encourages Timothy to help godly people to be content with what they have and to not be greedy. Living for wealth only plunges people into ruin. It is the LOVE of money that messes people up: that goes for both the rich and the poor. J.D. Rockefeller referred to his lifetime practice of tithing as a way of honoring God. God inspires us also to tithe. Our giving is always a witness to the love of God, who owns everything. We are only managers of the good things God 'lends us' in this lifetime. We regularly evaluate our giving to God through the church. We talk and pray about it, seeking to do good, rich in good deeds, and willing to share. Churches often miss the mark: calling people to give because of an immediate need which must be met. But we give because we were created to give, like God! The Bible shows us many people who were reluctant to give thankfully. It also notes those who demonstrated sacrificial giving. Let's pray abot our giving as we are seek to honor God! Sharing freely is the <u>life that is truly life</u>. **(1 Tim. 6:6-19)**
