

He issued this as a pamphlet in 1780; the form was used without much alteration for 100 years. Over time, changes have been made to address people's spiritual needs. This service follows Wesley's closely, 'with a deep sense of the importance of the service which has been a fruitful source of blessing to Methodism since 1755'.

FROM LAST WEEK...It was our Sunday after Christmas "Carol-Sing"! The song "Child So Lovely" is a traditional Christmas lullaby from Venezuela which gives great honor to Mary. "Joy To The World" is based on a Psalm and pictures Christ's 2<sup>nd</sup> coming more than it His first! We rejoice that Jesus "rules the world with truth and grace". "The Virgin Mary Had a Baby Boy" is a song from Trinidad that welcomed celebration as wandering musicians share joy! In "Angels We Have Heard On High" we wonder if the shepherds know what they had seen and heard in the manger. "Rock-a-Bye, My Dear Little Boy" has a hint of melancholy as Mary considers her baby's future. Joseph named the little baby: "Jesus": which means "God saves". "It Came Upon the Midnight Clear" doesn't mention the birth of Christ, but embraces the ways of peace in our current culture. "Away In A Manger" came about in our own Pennsylvania. The Savior who fits us for Heaven is one who also cries like any baby. We pray that He would stay by our cradle "til morning is nigh". "That Beautiful Name" is one that we should be honored to "name every day". "Bring a Torch, Jeannette Isabella" was a dance tune telling of Christ's birth and a journey to tell all the villagers. "I Heard The Bells On Christmas Day" came from Longfellow's tragedy: God is not dead after all. Even if you don't like figgy pudding, "We Wish You A Merry Christmas!" Pastor Mike told us that our Newborn King calls us to be "Getting Around To It": all the Christmas ways of mercy and love.
