

<u>MINISTRY CHALLENGE</u>...Are you forgiven? If so, act that way! As a person who is saved and forgiven by God's grace, be challenged to serve in a spirit of HUMILITY. Remember that you yourself was once a person who was lost, an outsider needing God.

<u>LAST WEEK</u>...God came to us in Jesus to redeem us from sin. That message is still celebrated a week after Christmas. Two great Bible heroes named Simeon and Anna help us to realize this truth. After Jesus was circumcised (at 8 days old) his parents went to temple for ceremonies of purification and dedication. Simeon was promised he'd see Messiah before he died; it was # 1 on his "bucket list". Beholding this 40-day-old child, Simeon took Jesus in his arms and thanked God. He rejoiced to see the coming of salvation. He spoke of a suffering which would come: an early prophecy of Jesus' crucifixion. The prophetess Anna also gave God thanks for this precious child. She had hardship after living many years, but this widow STILL blessed God for His faithfulness. We begin our new year right by doing as Simeon and Anna did. When others put Christmas away, we practice a life of "being righteous and devout". God uses anyone who submits to his will. No matter your desperate condition, God helps you to share His offered salvation. What expectations do you have when you come to Church? Check your spiritual attitude. Make Jesus your # 1 Resolution. Resolve to see Him and share Him. We closed our worship with the annual Wesley covenant service, pledging our DEVOTION to Christ as we make ourselves available to the Lord always (Luke 2:21-40)
