<u>MINISTRY CHALLENGE</u> Do something "Christian-nice" for someone. As you do, let them know that "Jesus loves you". Most folks will come to understand that there's a connection between our surprising good works and God's awesome love in Christ!

LAST WEEK ... We believe certain things about Jesus. But the measure of faith is NOT our "talk"...it's in our "walk"! James asks a key Bible question: 'What good is it my brothers, if a man claims to have faith but has no deeds?' This seems to contradict New Testament truth that by faith alone ("sola fide") comes our salvation. Martin Luther didn't like James' letter; he and Apostle Paul knew that we cannot earn or buy our salvation. But we understand that the message of James does not contradict Paul. James is really saying "faith that really is true Christian faith will naturally express itself in action and living out the gospel". It doesn't just think, believe, say or affirm. It 'DOES'! If you are a believer in Jesus, your faith must be a dosomething faith or it's as good as dead. Such 'faith' is no good for our world, neighbors, church or any person in need. So, don't just smile at people in need and say "I'm praying for you". Let your love of Christ show in your giving witness. Your actions say more about your faith than your words do! May both faith and works be the oars which help 'row your boat'! HOW DO YOU DO your faith? (James 2:14-26)
