<u>MINISTRY CHALLENGE</u>...Saint Patrick is said to have introduced the Christian faith to Ireland. This "humble-minded man" thanked God for having made him a witness. May we, too, help move people from idol-worship into relationship with Jesus Christ.

<u>LAST WEEK</u> ... A certain trucker flew his lawn-chair way up into the sky with the help of some helium weather balloons. Such an experience would give us a whole new view! Jesus went up a hill with Peter, James & John, who then saw Jesus as He truly was: a shining and transfigured Messiah. Peter piped up: "let's make this moment last". The Heavenly Father told the disciples to obey His Son. That means to do His Will. Moses and Elijah ("the Law" and "the Prophets") were also present, but Jesus outshines them and all other "pretty good guys". Like some hospice patients, we are comforted when we know "everything is going to be fine". Yes, we like our "religious experiences": our mountaintop moments. But we weren't meant to stay there. Just as Jesus and his disciples came down that hill and immediately were confronted with a challenge and controversy, holy-time equips us for ministry "in the valley". Beyond our 'mountaintop moment', let's reflect God's love in our own shining witness. There will be a learning curve to it. So, let's get started! After all, "you just can't sit there" when there's a great JESUS TO SHOW: <u>In All His Glory!</u> (Mark 9:2-9)
