

<u>MINISTRY CHALLENGE</u>... Visit someone who needs encouragement. Someone in the hospital, or is shutin, or anyone who is active or inactive in church attendance. You can even "visit" on the phone. However you do it, your touch matters to friends!

LAST WEEK ... A funny commercial pictures an EMU being told that he is "just a flightless bird!" Sometimes, it feels like things roll along, destined for certain fate. But God shows up to turn things around. We are thinking about the Bible's "But God" moments. In a 1 Cor. 3:6, Paul speaks of how HE planted (the gospel), his colleague Apollos watered it, But God made it grow. God is behind our every success. Psalms 49:14-15 reminds us that we are sheep facing a sad grave. But God redeems me from the realm of the dead... We should help the wicked to find reason to trust in our good Savior. Acts 2:24 teaches the rescue of Jesus as a sign of our own victory. But God raised him from the dead, freeing him from the agony of death...because it was impossible for death to keep its hold on him. We are people of the Resurrection! 1 Samuel 23:14 reminds us of David, being pursued by a jealous king Saul. King Saul relentlessly hunts him. But God did not give David into his hands. When evil hounds US, we have assurance that God will protect us. Romans 5:6-8 tells us of a love even greater than dying for a "good guy". But God ... demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Our service helps others to see the Lord at work right here. As we share His love, may people come to say: "But God came to me. Didn't see that one coming!"
