According to Decree 11,615/2023, the acquisition of 2 (two) weapons for personal defense is allowed, as long as it proves effective need. The acquisition of ammunition is allowed, with a limit of 50 (fifty) ammunition per weapon each year.

How much does the firearm purchase permit cost?

How long does it take to get the firearm purchase authorization?

On average, 30 calendar day(s) is the estimated time for the provision of this service. The estimated deadline is for the decision of the process, from the presentation of the documentation at a Federal Police unit.

Political progress in society's possibilities of self-defense

The Plenary of the Federal Senate approved this Wednesday (26), with 38 votes in favor, 4 against and 2 abstentions, the bill that allows residents in rural areas, over 21 years old, to buy firearms. PLS 224/2017 now goes to the Chamber of Deputies for analysis.

Authored by then-Senator Wilder Moraes, the bill establishes that residents of rural areas will be able to acquire firearms of permitted use to use in the safety of their family and property. The proposal modifies the Disarmament Statute (Law 10.826, of 2003) and had as rapporteur Senator Sérgio Petecão (PSD-AC).

The approved text imposes conditions for residents in rural areas to conquer the right. In addition to being over 21 years old, interested parties will need to present a personal identification document, proof of residence and a certificate of good record.

These three requirements are already made for those who live in rural areas and act as hunters to provide for their family's subsistence. But, in this case, the Disarmament Statute stipulates the minimum age of 25 years for the subsistence hunter to have a gun granted by the Federal Police.

"We propose this project aiming to ensure that residents in rural areas have the right to acquire a firearm for permitted use on their properties, which are often hundreds of kilometers from a police station, which puts countless families at the mercy of attacks by criminals or even wild animals. they do not have any means of defending their life and property", explained the author in the justification of the project.

Different Ities

Although PLS 224/2017 sets a lower age than that required for the subsistence hunter for the resident of the rural area to obtain possession of the weapon, the rapporteur assessed that this distinction should be maintained.

"As it is not about carrying the firearm, but about the mere possibility of acquisition, we understand that the minimum age requirement can be reduced for people over 21 years old", argued the rapporteur.

Through his amendment, Petecão only tried to adjust the text of the Disarmament Statute to allow residents in rural areas to obtain the right to own firearms at a younger age.

The bill was approved at the end of 2017 by the Commission on Constitution, Justice and Citizenship (CCJ) and would go straight to the Chamber of Deputies. However, there was an appeal for the matter to be considered in the Senate Plenary as well.

Project advances to allow the purchase of firearms by rural producers Written by Buy Rural News
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The project that authorizes the purchase of firearms by rural producers, as long as they reside in rural properties, was approved by the Agriculture Commission, Livestock, Supply and Rural Development of the Chamber of Deputies. The agribusiness caucus in the National Congress celebrated an important legislative advance this Wednesday (12/4). The Committee on Agriculture, Livestock, Supply and Rural Development of the Chamber of Deputies approved the bill that authorizes the purchase of firearms by rural producers residing in rural properties. The initiative, which meets resistance from the government base, represents a relaxation in the Disarmament Statute, in force since 2003, and aims to meet the security demands of rural residents. Understand the project that allows the purchase of firearms by rural producers and its

main points The text, authored by Senator Wilder Morais (PL-GO), has already been approved in the Federal Senate and is now being analyzed in the Chamber. It amends the Disarmament Statute to allow citizens over 21 years of age, residing in rural areas, to acquire firearms, as long as they comply with the legal requirements already established.

Historical das Forjes Taurus

Taurus was founded in 1939, on the eve of World War II. In July 1980, Taurus acquired all the shares of the Brazilian subsidiary of Indústria e Comércio Beretta S.A., with Italian capital, based in São Paulo, specialized in the manufacture of pistols and machine guns. With this, Taurus starts to produce semi-automatic pistols, increasing its production capacity and product line.

In 1981, the company opened Taurus International Manufacturing Inc., in Miami, South Florida, USA. This move marks the beginning of Taurus' history in the United States and consolidates the company's position in the main product lines of pistols, revolvers, tactical weapons and sporting weapons.

Two years after the inauguration of Taurus International Manufacturing Inc., Taurus Blindagens Ltda. was created, a company of the group responsible for the production of shields and bulletproof vests.

In 1994, Taurus is certified in ISO 9000 Series 9001. Subsequently, Underwrites Laboratories (UL) ratified the certification, with recognition in the United States.

In 1997, in another strategic move, Taurus acquires the licensing of handguns (revolvers) from Rossi, increasing its product portfolio and market share in the United States.

In 2008, the company invested in the expansion of the production of long guns at the São Leopoldo unit and in another move acquires the licensing of long guns from Rossi. In 2011, an important corporate restructuring was carried out, which changed the composition of the capital stock, now with a reference shareholder, Estima/Invespar.

In addition, it began a broad process of improving corporate governance, with the adhesion, in July 2011, to Level 2 of corporate governance of the Brazilian Stock Exchange, with the consequent advantages and guarantees assured to its shareholders, increasing its institutional image in the Brazilian Stock Exchange. In 2012, further strengthening its American DNA, Taurus acquires Heritage, manufacturer of the classic Single Action revolver.

In 2014, Taurus is acquired by Companhia Brasileira de Cartuchos (CBC), which made Taurus' globalization and technological leverage gain a new pace.

In 2016, the process of structural change in the company's operation began, starting with the transfer of the factory from Porto Alegre, including the administrative area, to São Leopoldo, consolidating the production of weapons in Brazil into a single industrial unit, which was completed in 2017.

In recent years, Taurus has stood out for great advances, marking a journey of transformation and modernization. The company's new phase was driven by continuous investments in technology, the implementation of more sustainable processes and the development of new materials and equipment, interconnected to the concept of Industry 4.0. At the same time, Taurus maintains a firm commitment to the training of its employees, promoting an environment of personal and professional growth that is an essential part of its ESG vision. This tripod – technological innovation, human appreciation and collaborative environment – sustains Taurus' strategy for the future, consolidating its relevance on the world stage.

The result of the investment in technology and innovation is the delivery of disruptive products to the market, such as the GX4 Graphene pistol, which is the first gun in the world with graphene, was developed in partnership with the University of Caxias do Sul (UCS) and used 100% national technology. This pistol started the 3rd generation of Taurus pistols.



TAURUS' WORLDWIDE PRESENCE

Currently, Taurus is present in more than 100 countries on 5 continents.

At our Headquarters, in São Leopoldo, Rio Grande do Sul, the industrial plant has a total area of 50,500 m², where the independent production lines for pistols, revolvers, tactical weapons and long guns are located, in addition to the Brazil/United States Integrated Center for Technology and Engineering (CITE).

Taurus' first production unit outside Brazil was inaugurated in 1981, in Miami, Florida (USA). In 2019, the factory was moved to Georgia. Taurus' production unit in the United States is now in Bainbridge and has a production capacity of 4 thousand guns per day, where it also houses the Heritage factory, brand of legendary cowboy revolvers.

Taurus' manufacturing facility in India is in Hisar (Haryana). The factory was inaugurated in 2022 and is part of the "Make in India" program, meeting the demand of the civilian and military arms markets in India.

Since 2022, Taurus has maintained a local office to meet Saudi Arabia's demands.

Conclusion

This new caliber was developed in response to new rules imposed by the Federal Government,

which established specific limits for weapons of permitted use. Meeting these requirements, the .38 TPC promises to satisfy the needs of Brazilian consumers by providing greater power, control and cost-effectiveness in their shooting operations.

The fact is that the .38TPC is a 9mm type less, and there will be no shot difference between the full 9 and the smaller 9 which is even stronger than the 380 ACP.
