Answer Explanations for English Tense Quiz (A2 Level)

1. **She walks to school every day.**
 - Explanation: The present tense for he/she/it adds an "s" at the end of the verb. So, "walk" becomes "walks."
2. **They are playing football right now.**
 - Explanation: Present continuous tense is formed with the verb "to be" (are/is/am) + verb + "ing." "Playing" shows the action happening now.
3. **Yesterday, I visited my grandparents.**
 - Explanation: Past tense of "visit" is "visited." It shows the action happened before now.
4. **I will go to the park tomorrow.**
 - Explanation: Future tense is formed using "will" + base form of the verb. "Will go" indicates an action that will happen later.
5. **He is reading a book.**
 - Explanation: Present continuous tense uses "is" + verb + "ing." It describes an action happening right now.

6. **We watched a movie last night.**

- Explanation: Past tense of "watch" is "watched," showing completed action in the past.

7. **(Student's own sentence)**

- Explanation: The sentence should use "will" + verb to talk about future plans, e.g., "I will visit my friend next weekend."

Explications des réponses pour le quiz de temps en anglais (niveau A2)

1. Elle va à l'école tous les jours.

- Explication : Le temps présent pour il/elle/on ajoute un **"s"** à la fin du verbe. Donc, "walk" devient **"walks"**.

2. Ils jouent au football en ce moment.

- Explication : Le présent continu se forme avec le verbe **être** (sont/est/suis) + verbe + **"ing"**. "Playing" montre une action qui se passe **maintenant**.

3. Hier, j'ai rendu visite à mes grands-parents.

- Explication : Le passé de "visit" est **"visited"**. Cela montre que l'action s'est produite **avant maintenant**.

4. J'irai au parc demain.

- Explication : Le futur se forme avec **"will"** + base du verbe. "Will go" indique une action qui se passera **plus tard**.

5. Il est en train de lire un livre.

- Explication : Le présent continu utilise **"is"** + verbe + **"ing"**. Cela décrit une action qui se déroule **en ce moment**.

6. Nous avons regardé un film hier soir.

- Explication : Le passé de "watch" est **"watched"**, indiquant une action **terminée** dans le passé.

7. (Phrase de l'élève)

- Explication : La phrase doit utiliser **"will"** + verbe pour parler des **plans futurs**, par exemple, "Je rendrai visite à mon ami le week-end prochain."
