POLICY NUMBER: 18-003

- Illinois Open Meeting Act (OMA) any member of the public may record either by tape, video, film or other means the public officials at an open meeting unless there is a legal reason that permits the public body to meet in closed, or executive session.
- Any type of recording shall not disrupt any of the public meetings by noise, distractions, or other means.
- Video of the public meeting must be at the far end of the members and not interfere with the other public's view, hearing or be in the way of seating or walking area.
- Owners of video machines must supply any extension cords that are needed.
- Any disruption from any recording device may be asked to be removed from the meeting.
